Summary: Investigation of NPS Superintendent

Report Date: April 16, 2014

We investigated an allegation that a National Park Service (NPS) park superintendent occasionally used park housing for personal use to stay overnight. Our investigation substantiated the allegation. We found that the superintendent violated the park's Housing Management Plan. In addition, we found that while the superintendent paid a daily rate for some nights of stay, they could not show that they paid for all nights.

We referred our investigation to NPS, which disciplined the superintendent for "Conduct Unbecoming a Superintendent" by suspending the superintendent, without pay, for 5 days.
